(Mark 10:32-45)

We are living in a topsy-turvy world; a world where people do not know what is right from wrong; a world of people without morality, without respect of life and certainly without respect and fear of God (Judges 21:25, Isaiah 5:20). People see the preaching of the cross as foolishness (1 Cor. 1:18). But for Christians, the cross and the death of Christ is a power, transforming reality (Gal. 6:14, 1 Cor.2:2). We see three dimensions of Jesus's greatness shown in this text.
