OVERCOMING LIFE'S SETBACKS

2 Kings 5:1-15

SETBACKS can be good, and God allows them to happen in our lives, first to change us from within - to change our hearts and characters; and then for us to realize that He is all that we ever need.

PRINCIPLES TO APPLY WHEN SETBACKS HAPPEN

A. God Is Our Only Way – _____ Him (Verses 2-5)

- God uses crises in life to wake us up and help us see what truly matters in life.
- The crisis Naaman was in led him to the God of Israel.
- God meets us in our time of need.
- Setbacks make us realize that what we truly need in this life is God, and more of Him.

B. God's Way Is Different From Ours – _____ to Him (Verses 9-12)

- God is not just concerned with solving our problems, but He is more concerned with developing in us faith, obedience and humility.
- God uses setbacks as a tool to create submission in us, so that we can learn what it means to obey His will and not our own.
- We need Christian friends who will come alongside us in times of setbacks and crises. (Verse 13)

C. God's Way Is Faith – _____ **Him** (Verses 14-15)

- You can trust God. Never mind if you do not understand everything; do as He says.
- Naaman's eventual faith in God caused him to be healed and be saved.
 (Luke 4:27)

There are times when the Lord allows us to lose the things we hold dear in our lives - position, possession, health, and even people (where we put our security in) so that we will realize that <u>God is ultimately all that we truly need</u>, and the only one we can depend on.
