Man's behavior is governed by what's in his heart (Prov. 23:7; 4:23; Matt. 12:34). The way a person conducts himself becomes the test of true genuine saving faith (Rom. 2:13, John 14:15,23 15:10,14; 1 John 2:3, Luke 11:28, John 13:17, John 14:24).

Our response to God's word determines the condition of our heart and the nature of our faith (1 John 3:10). The proper response or reaction to the Word of God is obedience (Luke 6:46-48). There are only two reactions to God's word.
