Yet through it all, we find the Bible to be accurate, constant, and proven to be right. Inspired by the Holy Spirit, we have the complete, indestructible Word of God. Isaiah 40:8, Matthew 24:35
2.	In Psalm 19 God is revealed through nature. In second half of the Psalm God Himself reveals that His Law, testimonies, statues, commandments, fear, and judgements are perfect sure, right, pure, clean, and true His word is. The scripture is of the Lord, by the Lord, and the benefits are for us, even the salvation of our souls. Proverbs 119:174, 105, 14, Proverbs 6:23, 1 Cor. 1:18, Proverbs 119: 92.
<i>3</i> .	God has preserved and revealed His word. He wants us to know it and to know Him, and we can through Jesus. Jesus is the truth in all of scripture (John 5:39). His words are Spirit and life (John 6:63) and are powerful to save us. Truth is more than some fact or idea, truth acts upon us. Why is Jesus the truth?
