Jesus' Great Commission involves teaching the people of God the Word of God. Jesus said "teach them to observe everything I have commanded you" (Matt. 28:20). Jesus' teachings, commands and instructions comprehensively include divine truths about God and man, life and death, sin and salvation, righteousness and unrighteousness, the church and the world, angels and demons, eternal heaven and eternal hell. The entire Scriptures, both the Old and the New Testament have one voice proclaiming the glory of the person, work and teachings of Jesus (John 5:39; 1 Cor. 1:23; Col. 1:28). The church is mandated by Christ to teach God's people the whole counsel of God written in His Word (Acts 20:27). The singular direction of the teaching and pulpit ministry of our church is geared towards the faithful proclamation and preaching of sound doctrine for godly living (2 Tim. 4:3-4).
