

THE KING WHO DIED FOR MY SIN

(Luke 23:39-43)

The central figure in all of history is no other than our Lord Jesus Christ. The whole world cannot deny the global influence of the life and legacy of this man who claims to be God the Son, the King of kings and the only divine Savior who alone is the source and giver of eternal life. Jesus is indeed the dividing figure of all humanity. What one does with Christ determines his/her eternal destiny (John 3:36; Matthew 25:31-34,41). It was no accident then that on the Cross of Calvary, Jesus was at the very center, crucified between two criminals, serving as the saving King of those who genuinely trust in Him and the sovereign Judge of those who finally reject Him. Reflecting from this historical moment that took place on the Cross of our King, let's consider these three evidences of God's converting work in the life of a true believer.

1. Reverential

(Luke 23:41; 1 Peter 2:22; 1:19; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Ephesians 1:4-6; 1 Peter 2:9)

3. Repentant

(Luke 23:42-43; Matthew 1:21; Revelation 2:7; 5:13; Ephesians 2:8-9)
